

## Germantown Spassfest Walk Second 5k

Turn left on Park Road.

At end of the road on the left side of road is the Red Schoendienst plaque which is a replica of Red Schoendienst's plaque in Cooperstown's Baseball Hall of Fame.

Turn left on East Park Road.

Turn left on Sycamore Street.

Cross Hanover Street.

Turn right on sidewalk on Hanover Street. Note the 100 year old pecan tree on the left.

Turn left on Walnut Street.

Turn right on Prairie Street.

Pass the Germantown Fire Department on right with the beautiful bell.

Turn left on Main Street.

Turn left on Locust Street.

Turn right on Walnut Street.

Turn right on Molitor Street.

Turn right on Church Street.

Turn left on West Street.

Turn right on Main Street

Turn left on Green Street.

Turn right on Mill Street.

Turn right on Prairie Street.

Turn left on Clinton Street.

The house at 601 Clinton was built by Red Schoendienst's grandfather about 1870. House is known as the Schoendienst-Albers-Tobin Home.

Pass old smoke stack on left & old power plant (white brick building) on right.

Turn right on Hanover Street.

Turn left on Church Street.

Turn right on Maple Street.

Turn left on Holly Street.

Turn left on East Park Road.

Turn left on Park Road.

Continue on Park Road to start/ check point/finish.
